

- Communicate between home and school through a variety of different methods (including newsletters, emails and the school website.)

I/we as Parents/Carers will:

- Not send my child to school, if they, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- Collect my child immediately if they become ill or show symptoms of COVID-19 whilst at school;
- Ensure that all contact details for my child are up to date and somebody is contactable at all times during the school day;
- Adhere to the social distancing measures in place when dropping off and picking my child up;
- Strictly stick to the timings issued for my child when dropping them off and picking them up;
- Ensure only one person will drop off/ pick up my child at/from school;
- Ensure my child does not bring any additional items into school with them or take unnecessary items home from school;
- Remind my child about social distancing and handwashing rules;
- Send my child to school in freshly washed clothing each day;
- Wait until the office lobby becomes free of others before entering, if I need to speak with a member of the office staff;
- Communicate with teachers via telephone or email;
- Support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- Support my child with all home learning activities, especially if another lockdown occurs.
