



Superheroes



Below are five options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project we must stress that it is quality not quantity that counts; we would rather receive one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school in the week beginning 14th October. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in to view your finished work in the last week of term.

Project	Number of House Points Achievable
1) Make a vehicle for a superhero out of junk materials. Don't forget to give your superhero vehicle a name and some special features.	15
2) Make a wanted poster for a villain. It can be a villain you have read about in a comic book or one that you have made up. Don't forget to describe what they look like.	10
3) Design a superhero costume for a new superhero.	10
4) Ask your family and write about what super powers they would have if they could be a superhero for a day.	10
5) Make a comic book with a superhero comic story.	15
