TOWERS, TUNNELS AND TURRETS

Science

Children will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses. We will be carrying out experiments to investigate the suitability of a variety of materials and the strength of different materials for a bridge.

RE

The children will learn about Hindu celebrations and beliefs. A visitor will come into school to tell the story of Rama and Sita and explain how Hindus celebrate Diwali.

PSHE/SEAL

The focus this term will be on the children’s mental wellbeing. They will be encouraged to talk about their emotions and explain what to do when they feel sad. We will also look at staying safe when online.

History

We will begin this topic with an exciting visit to Lincoln Castle and will find out about the features of castles from different periods as well as the people who lived in a castle.
