Which room is the widest/longest in your

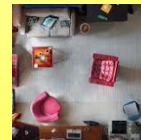
house?

Could you use a 'key' and have symbols for different pieces of furniture.

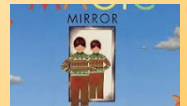
