## Term 3 - Year 1 homework project options

Below are four options for homework projects for this term. Each project incorporates different skills and you should choose at least one of these to complete before the end of term. Each project has a number of house points attached to it; we have allocated the number of house points according to the level of difficulty/time needed for each project.

Although you may choose to complete more than one project, we must stress that it is the quality not the quantity that counts. We would rather have one well-researched, carefully thought out and beautifully presented project rather than three rushed pieces.

All projects should be returned to school Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February. We will then arrange a time for parents to come in and view your finished work in the last week of term.

Project	Number of house points achievable
1. Make a famous London landmark using cardboard boxes and other recycled materials. It could be The Tower of London, The London Eye, Big Ben, the Houses of Parliament or another landmark that you are interested in or have visited.	15
2. Search the web or use non-fiction books to find out about a famous London landmark. Make an information booklet by writing down interesting facts, downloading images and /or making drawings.	15
3. Make a map of the City of London, including famous streets and landmarks. Can you include a key to show each of the landmarks?	10
4. Make a poster encouraging people to take a holiday in London. Look at travel brochures and holiday websites to help you. What can they see and do in London?	10
