

English

This term in our English we will be using the popular children's book *The Tiger who came to Tea*. This will inspire us to write a diary entry as if we were Sophie. We will be also doing lots of visual literacy using the Disney Pixar films of *Toy Story*. From this we will develop character studies and describe settings.

Science
