Draw the mini-beasts and then use the internet to try and identify them.

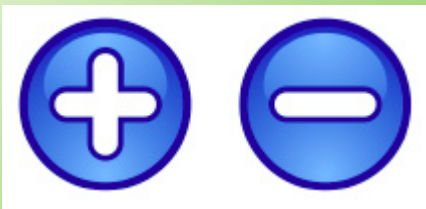


## Home Learning Projects Year 2: 1st June to 14th June
