

English

In English we will start 'sentence stacking' as we prepare to make steps towards Year 2 and the expectations for the coming writing curriculum.

We will use a story a week as a stimulus and model of how to construct our own stories. We will use well known stories such as 'Owl Babies' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. The children will create their own versions, including their choice of verbs and adjectives.

Our big question is 'What do people learn from stories and festivals?'. In this unit we will be learning about Moses and the importance of Hannukah to Jewish people. We will also be learning about parables in Christianity.
