

## English

In reading this term we begin the book 'A Place Called Perfect' by Helena Duggan. We will use the non-fiction book 'Our Planet' to write non-chronological reports about an animal of our choosing. Continuing the nature theme, we will read and compose haikus with a focus on the changing seasons.

## Science

In science we will be looking inwards to the workings of the digestive system! We will be learning about the role that each tooth plays in breaking up food. We will create food chains to show how energy and matter moves through an ecosystem. We will be investigating to discover what happens to our teeth and what the best drink is to keep our teeth healthy.

## Maths

In maths we continue to apply our multiplication and division skills by learning new formal written methods for division and subtraction. We will consolidate our understand of length and perimeter before learning about improper fractions and mixed numbers.

## PE

Year 4 will be doing dance in their indoor PE slots and will be using mirroring and matching to create dances with a carnival theme. During our outdoor learning sessions, the children will be basing their lessons on the Ancient Egyptians which will be brilliant: they will be sourcing and recreating the weapons they used, their shelters and their clothing.



## Art & DT

In Art, we will be focusing on learning different painting techniques to create clouds, water and foliage. We will then use a range of materials (such as bubble wrap, cotton buds, card or bottle tops) alongside paint to create these paintings.

In DT, we will be creating books sleeves using our textile skills.

## PSHE

During our PSHE lessons this term, we will be learning about how to keep safe both online and in the real world. We will look at how we need to check carefully about what to post online as this can endanger us; we will also learn about different types of medications and drugs and how to identify risks.

## Term 3

Where does our food come from?

## RE

Our RE unit is called 'How people celebrate marriage?' This term we will focus on learning about both Christian and Jewish wedding ceremonies and will learn the symbolism behind different elements of these wedding ceremonies before next term moving onto Sikh wedding traditions. Children will share any experiences of weddings they may have attended.

## Geography

We will be asking 'Where does our food come from?' in our geography lessons this term. We will be considering what kinds of foods grow in which biomes. We will be evaluating the impact that food production has on a place, whether positive or negative.

## Computing

During our computing lessons, we will be exploring what the internet means, how we connect using the internet and what a webpage is. We will also be learning about how to differentiate between a truth online and fake news.

## French

In French, the children will be learning about Boucle d'or et les Trois Ours (Goldilocks and the three bears). They will use picture cards to sequence the story correctly and repeat words that match the pictures. They will then use their knowledge to create their own story board in French.
