

English

This term, we will be starting off by innovating the story of Little Red before looking at letters in the Day the Crayons Quit. Towards the end of the term, we will be writing instructions linked to a Christmas theme and looking at Poetry. We will solve What am I? riddles and create our own.

PSHE

The focus this term will be on 'Valuing Differences'. We will be exploring what makes us who we are, identifying people who are special in our lives, we will consider how our actions make others feel and discussing how to help someone who feels left out.

Maths

We will continue to work on addition and subtraction, looking at number bonds and learning how to add and subtract by making exchanges. We will also work on shape, learning to recognise 2D and 3D shapes.

Geography

We will begin this topic of Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place? by looking at the continents and the Poles. We will then discover what it is like in the North and South Pole before comparing the UK to Kenya. We will then decide which place we would prefer to live.

PE

The children will develop their ball skills by throwing and catching, hitting a target and rolling, dribbling and kicking. They will also develop their gymnastic skills of jumping, rolling, balancing and travelling individually and in combination to create short sequences. The children will also take part in mindfulness this term.

R.E

This term the children will learn about Christianity and we will investigate different types of Christian churches and understand their similarities and differences. We will describe why certain parts of a church are important to Christians and will explore the importance of Advent to Christians and will be visiting a local church.

Art

This term we will continue to focus on drawing skills and the work of Leonardo Da Vinci. We shall use our sketchbooks to practise using line and tone to draw shape, pattern and texture. We shall use the zoom feature in photography to show an object in detail before drawing it.
