

Science.

This term, we will learn about animals, including humans. We will explore the skeleton and bones, understanding their structure and function. We will also learn more about different types of nutrition.

Maths.

We will build on our knowledge of place value to 100. We will then deepen our understanding of addition and subtraction. We will focus on using concrete resources like base 10 and place value counters.

PSHE.

This term, we will explore our relationships with others. We will identify key people in our lives and understand what we can do to look after them.

Geography.

This term, we will explore the Earth's structure, investigating volcanoes, mountains, and earthquakes. We will also investigate where the rocks found around the school have originated from.

PE.

This term we will be developing the fundamental skills of balancing, running, jumping, hopping and skipping. We will also practice different throwing techniques and our accuracy when tracking a ball.

English.

This term, we will explore poetry and write our own acrostic poems all about us! We will then move onto narratives and a character description. Our guided reading lessons will focus on Leon and the Place Between and Nim's Island.

Art.

This term, we will evaluate the works of Yayoi Kusama and Georges Seurat. We will explore Kusama's use of patterns and bold colours and Seurat's pointillism technique. We will then create our own unique paintings.

RE.

This term, we will learn more about the religion of Islam. We will discuss the main beliefs including the creation story. We will also find out more about the three types of guidance Muslims believe God has provided.
