This term, we will learn about Hinduism and the creation story.

French

During French lessons we will be learning how to pronounce the names of ten animals. We will also be practicing writing these down. Then we will be learning how to use the singular verbs.

English

Maths

We will continue learning more about addition and subtraction.

This will include using the inverse operation to check our answers. We will then move on to multiplication and division. We will use facts from the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables.



How did daily life change in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age?

History

This term, we will investigate how daily life changed throughout the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will examine different artefacts, as well as learn about different animals that lived throughout the Palaeolithic and Mesolithic period. We will also explore how hunter gatherers found food sources.

PSHE
