Term 4
Friendship and Adventures
We will be learning about friendship and the people who are important to us, we will be creative and imagine far off places and travel.

Communication and Language Literacy

Using simple gestures such as pointing, waving or showing objects to communicate needs and interests

Following simple instructions like "Put on your shoes"

Children can hold object in secure grip and make marks

Physical

Moves around steadily, showing good balance whilst walking, climbing or changing direction

Runs and jumps with growing confidence, whilst managing to stay balanced

Uses blocks to freely stack, build and experiment with shapes and sizes

Maths

Explores space with their body through climbing, crawling and squeezing themselves through different objects like 'Tunnels'

Recognises and names simple colours

Habitats. How animals keep warm in winter.

Making bird feeders and talking about the RSPB.
