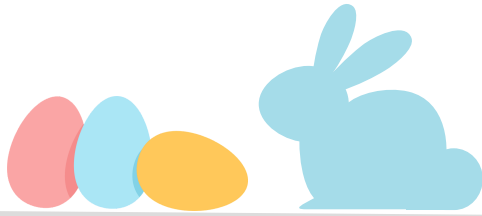

YEAR 2 - KINGFISHERS

This week, Kingfishers have been using positional language in maths, such as forwards, backwards, quarter and half turns and clockwise to guide each other through movements. We practiced making turns in different directions, carefully following instructions to stay on track. Then we held a competition to see which group could make their turns in perfect sync. The groups had to listen closely and communicate clearly so everyone moved at the same time. It was great to watch each team improve and become more coordinated.



YEAR 4 - CURLEWS

Year 4 had an exciting and educational trip to West Stow Anglo-Saxon Village, where they stepped back in time to explore life in the Anglo-Saxon period. The children investigated the reconstructed houses, discovering how people lived, worked, and built their homes over a thousand years ago. They also visited the museum, where they examined fascinating artefacts and learned more about daily life in the past. It was a memorable day full of hands-on learning, curiosity and historical discovery. I was so proud of their curiosity and their exceptional behaviour throughout.
