

English

In English we will continue 'sentence stacking' as we prepare for Year 2 and the expectations for the coming writing curriculum. We will use a story a week as a stimulus and model how to construct our own stories. We will use well known stories such as 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'The Billy Goat's Stuff'. The children will plan then write their own versions of these stories, including their choice of verbs and adjectives.

Continuing our big question from term 5 'What do people learn from stories and festivals?'. We will delve into why and how Christians celebrate Christmas. We will revisit the Jewish faith and learn about Rosh Hashanah and why Humanists value 'The Golden Rule'.
